A learnership is a vocational education and training programme to facilitate the link between structured learning and work experience in order to obtain a registered qualification.

Learnerships are the recommended framework within which to explore the new opportunities. They directly address the "how" of the Skills Development Strategy.

Learnerships are intended to address the gap between education and training provision and the needs of the labour market.

Criteria, as set out in the Skills Development Act, indicate that a learnership must:

- include a structured learning component;
- include practical work experience;
- lead to a qualification, and
- relate to an occupation.

The importance of learnerships

Learnerships in the Plastics sector:

- provide a programme which is outcomes-based;
- allow the learner access to a working environment (practical) that is pertinent to the theory;
- allow the learner to experience and understand the workplace dynamics;
- allow assessment to occur at various stages, based on the learner's competence (learner centred), and


The qualification gained is recognised nationally and, in many instances, is benchmarked against international standards.
