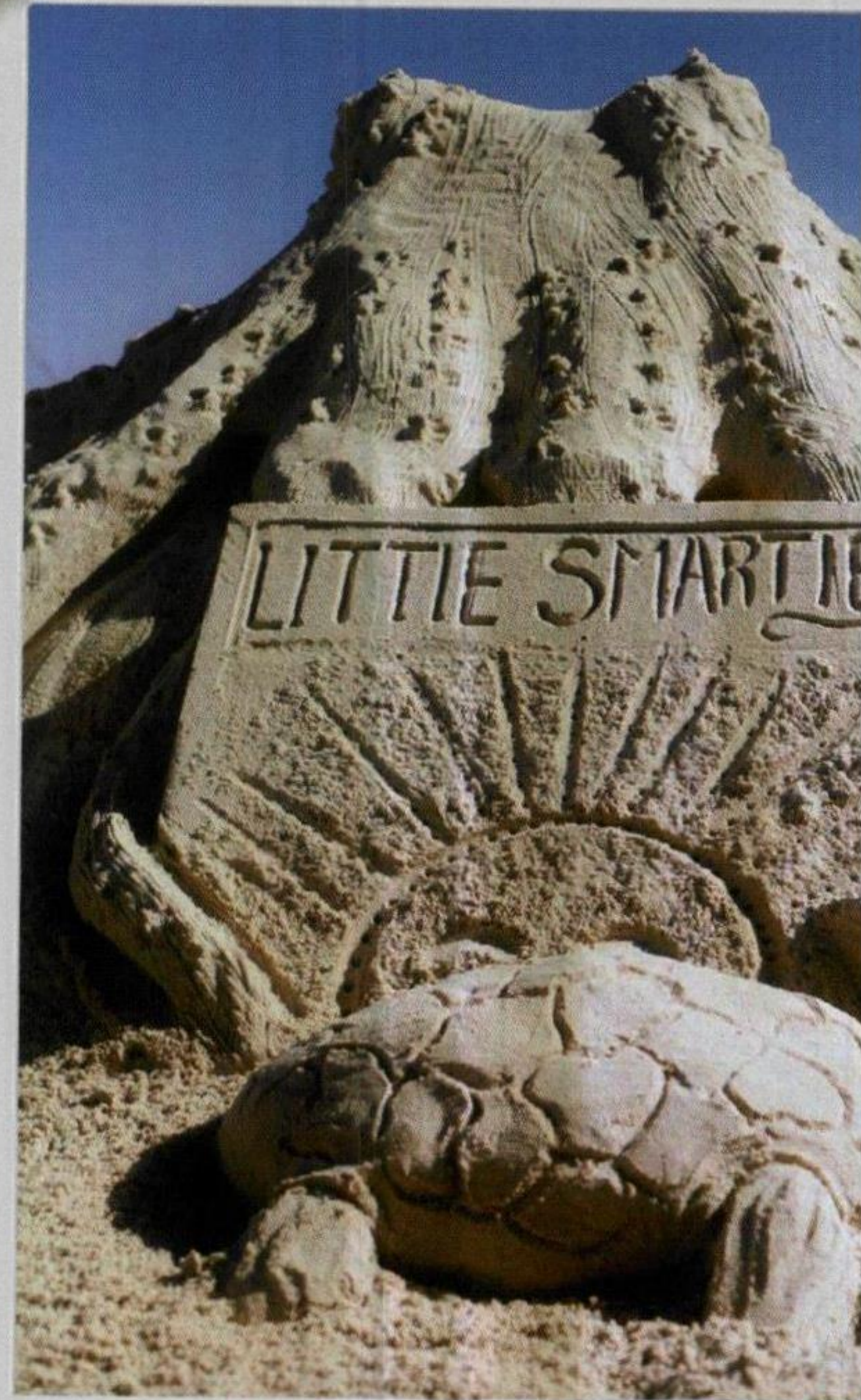


Plastics at Work

Smart-ie people in Smartie Town!



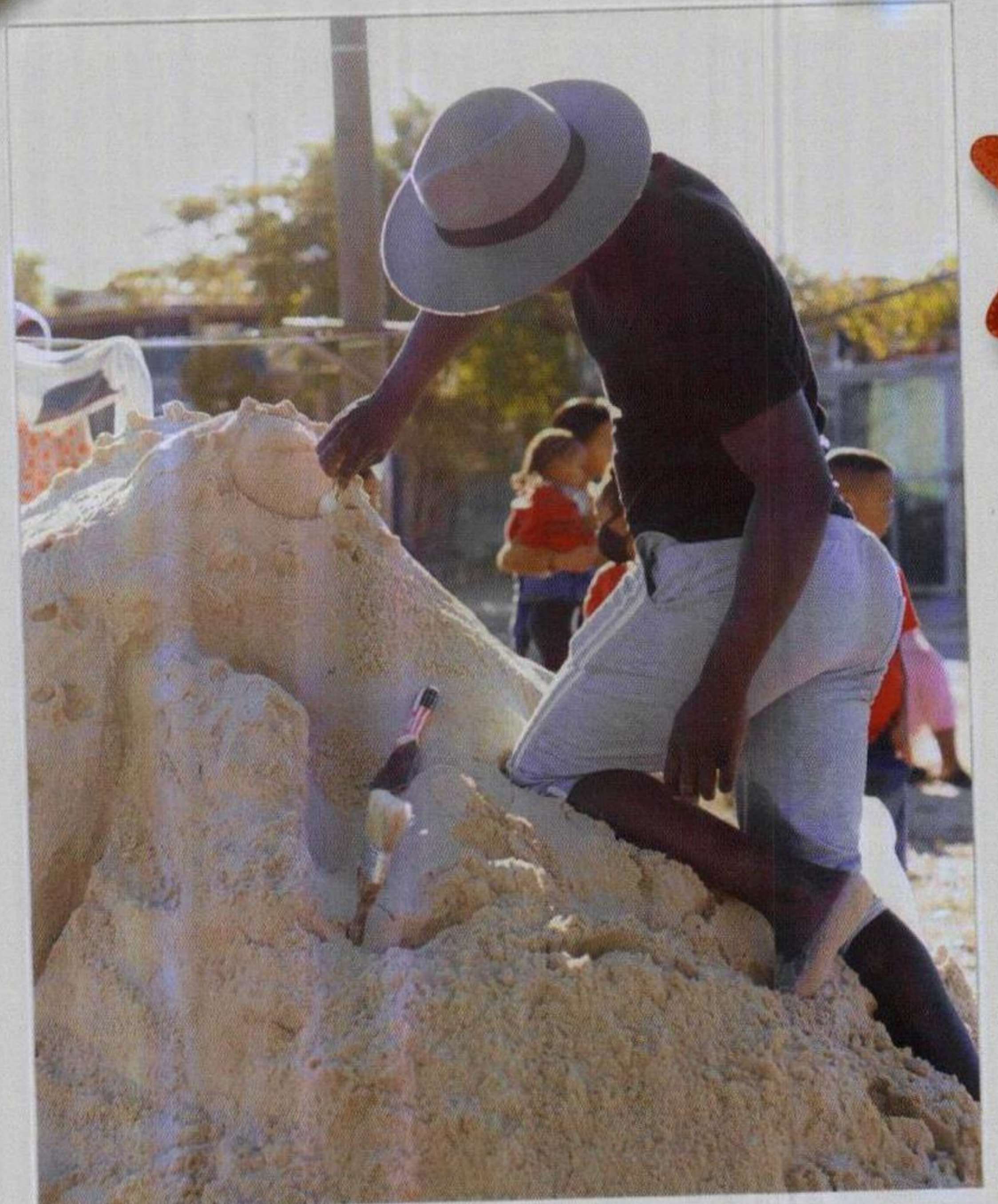
Did you know? 80% of plastic waste in the ocean starts as plastic litter on land, which enters our rivers and flows into the ocean.
